PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 4(1) (aaa), 4(1-A) of TNP Act in Cr.No.3 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was illegally transported 200 litres of arrack without any valid license and the same was seized by the respondent police. Hence, this complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner is a habitual offender and further submitted that there are seven previous cases pending against the petitioner.

5.Considering the fact that the petition is the habitual offender and there are seven previous cases pending against the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.

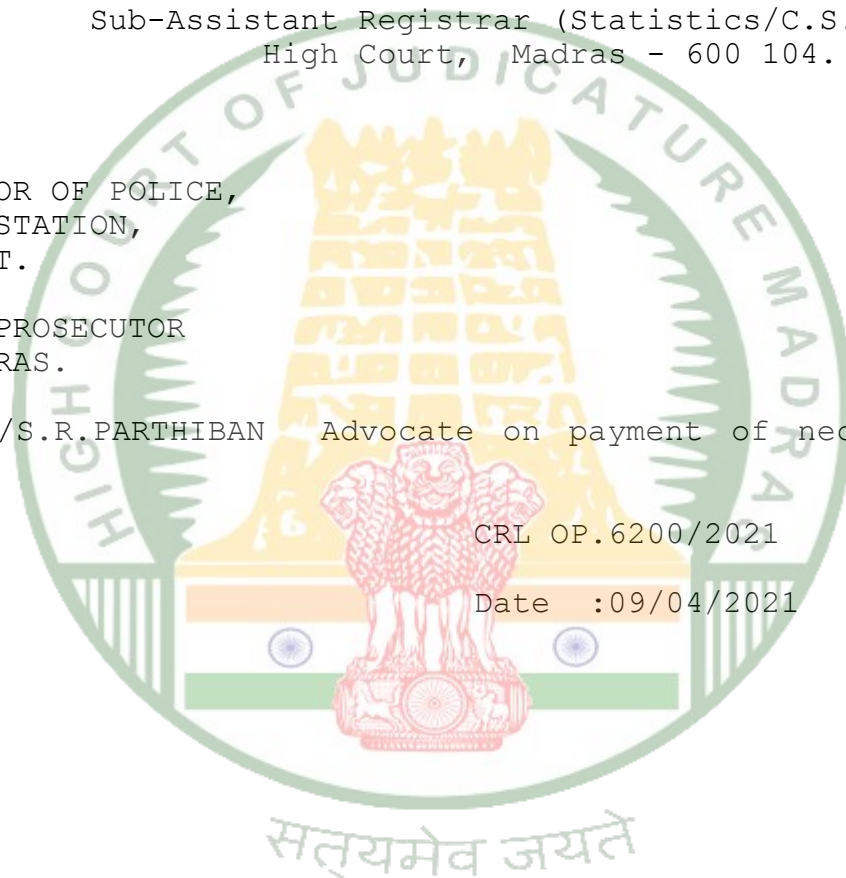
