Mr.S.Saravanan, learned counsel for petitioner and Mr.M.Sudarshan, learned counsel representing Mr.N.Damodaran, counsel on record for sole respondent are before this Virtual Court.

2. Prayer in captioned CMP is for 'Condonation of Delay' [COD] of 199 days in filing captioned Second Appeal. Reason for delay is articulated in paragraph 2 of the supporting affidavit, wherein the lock down has been cited as reason for delay in retrieving the case bundle from Chamber and removing the objection.
