Learned Government Advocate [Crl.side] would submit that the detention order passed against the detenu in Memo No.57/BCDFGISSSV/2021 dated 23.02.2021, on the file of the second respondent is revoked vide G.O.Rt.No.1699, Home, Prohibition and Excise (X) Department, dated 15.04.2021 and produced a copy of the said order.
