ORDER

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer sought for in the writ petition, and also the petitioner's application dated 27.03.2019 is pending with the second respondent, without going into the merits of the case, the second respondent is directed to consider the petitioner's application dated 27.03.2019 and pass suitable orders on merits and in accordance with law after giving opportunity to the petitioner as well as other affected parties, within a period of eight (8) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
