PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 376, 294(b), 506(1) of I.P.C. and under Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002, in Cr.No.1 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner had love affair with the defacto complainant, however, he refused to marry her.

5.Considering the gravity of the offence, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
