Prayer in W.P.No.6538 of 2013 :- Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, calling for the records of the first respondent relating to the seniority list vide reference No.CME/A1/25/12/MEE dated 25.01.2013 and quash the same and direct the 1st respondent to prepare a fresh panel of names including petitioner for the purpose of promotion to the post of Superintending Engineer (Mechanical).
