ORDER

This Civil Revision is filed against the petition and order dated 08.03.2016 in I.A.No.4 of 2016 in unnumbered I.A. in unnumbered R.C.A. on the file of the Rent Control Appellate Tribunal, Dharmapuri.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the present Civil Revision Petition is filed against the order dated 08.03.2016 in I.A.No.4 of 2016 in unnumbered I.A. in unnumbered R.C.A. to condone the delay of 389 days in representing the I.A. filed to set aside Section 5 application. He further submitted that since this Court has not granted any interim order pending Civil Revision Petition, the learned Judge numbered the I.A. filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act as I.A.No.5 of 2016 to condone the delay of 15 days in filing the R.C.A. and hence, he is not pressing the Civil Revision Petition but, prayed for speedy disposal of the said I.A.
