3. I had, on 17.04.2021 directed the respondent to consider and dispose the representation of the petitioner after hearing him. Today, order dated 30.06.2021 is circulated disposing the representation, though adverse to the petitioner. Thus, the



mandamus, as sought for, stands achieved and nothing further survives in this writ petition. Hence, this writ petition is dismissed. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to challenge order dated 30.06.2021, if he may so desire, in accordance with law. No costs.
