2.It is brought to the notice of this Court that pleadings are ready and the main Appeal Suit itself is ready for final hearing.

3.Having regard to the scope of this application/petition and the petitioner/appellant's right is protected, this Court is not inclined to grant any interim order. The respondents shall also not claim any right on the basis of anything that is being done during the pendency of this Appeal Suit. **Hence, the Civil Miscellaneous Petition stands dismissed.**



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4.It is also brought to the notice of this Court that the 2nd respondent is no more. Learned counsel for the petitioner/appellant is directed to take steps to bring on record, the legal representatives of the deceased/2nd respondent.

5.Post the main Appeal Suit for final hearing in the usual course.
