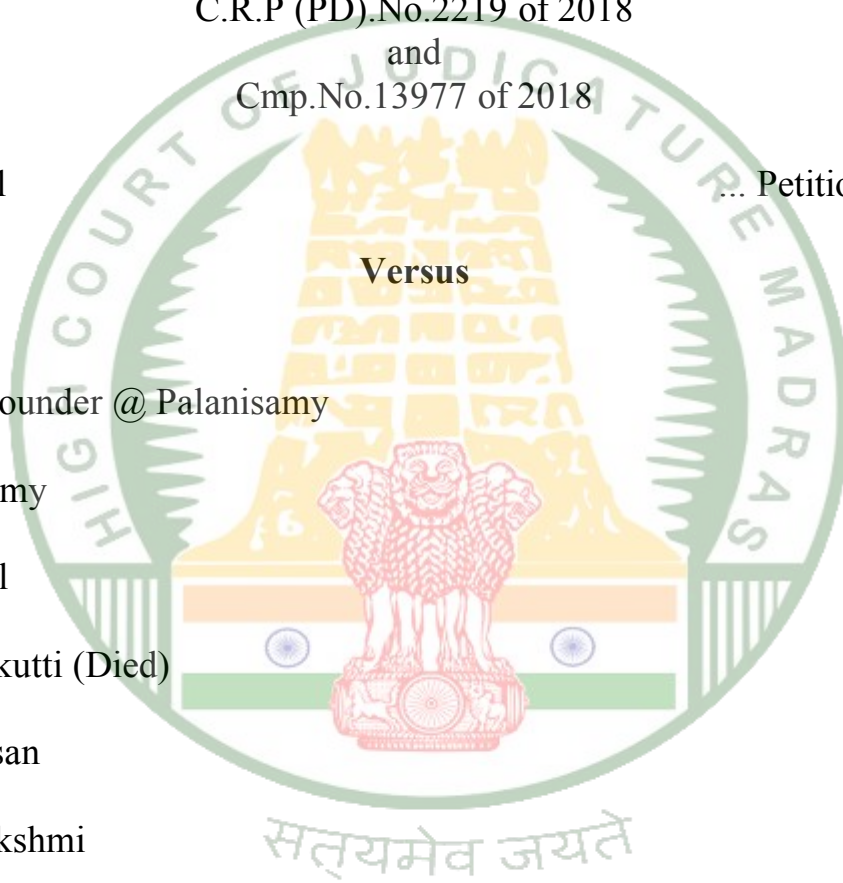

3.Though this Court directed the learned counsel for the petitioner to

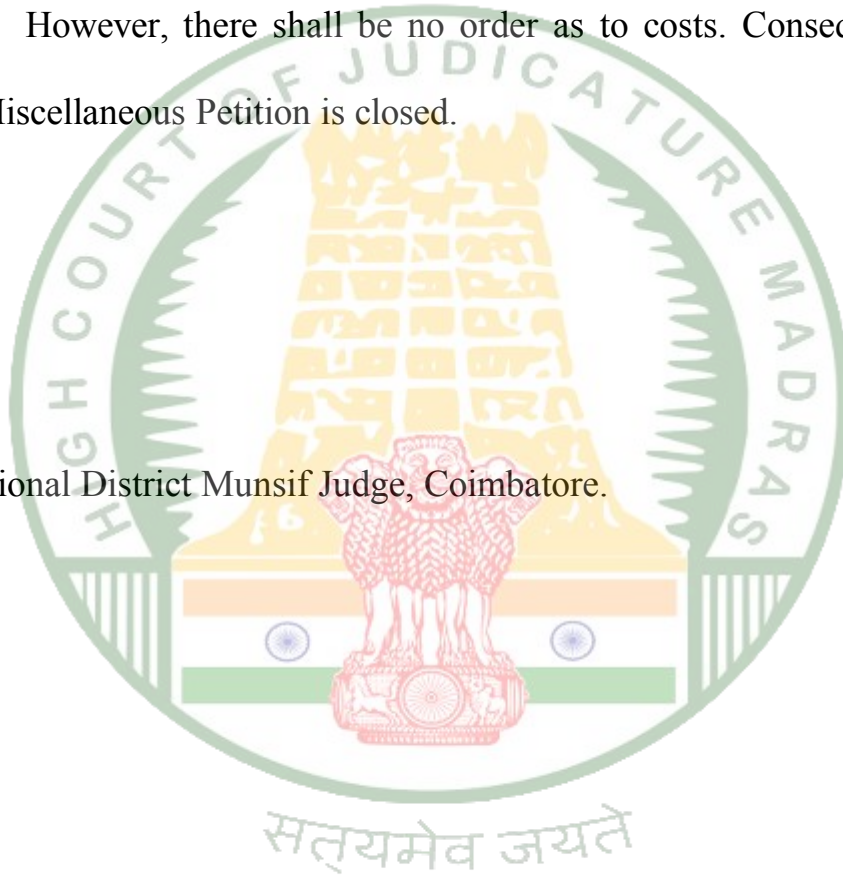

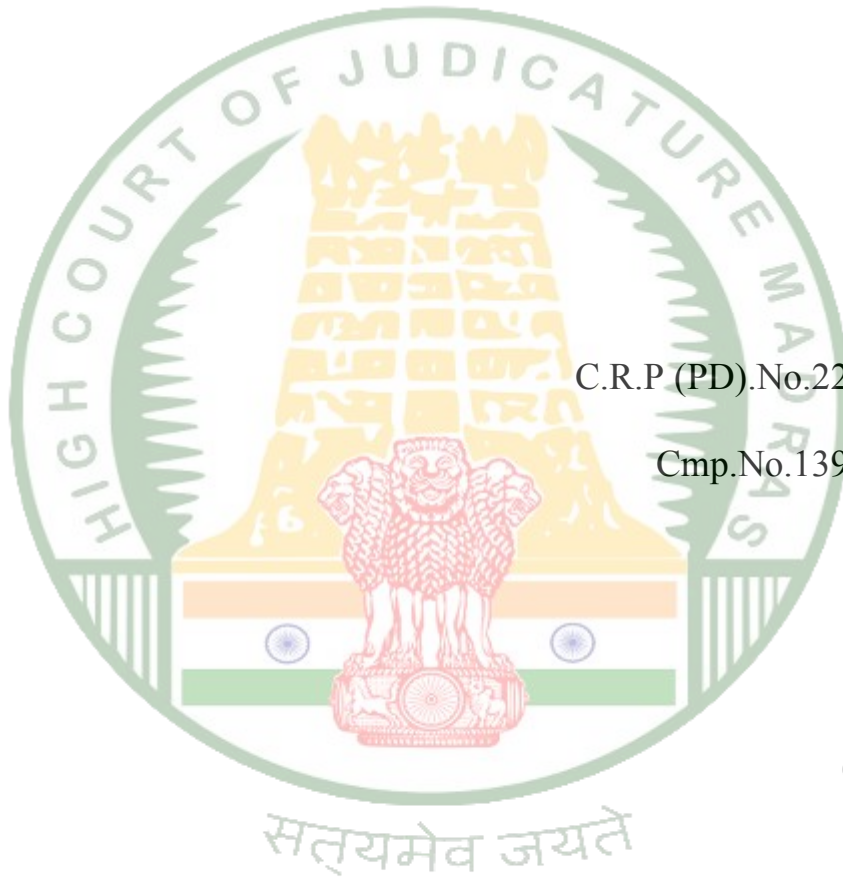
