PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 324 and 506(2) of IPC in Cr.No.not known of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that the injured has been discharged from the hospital.
