In the above circumstances, this petition is allowed by modifying the condition that the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police on every Monday at 10.30 a.m, until further orders. Except the above modification condition, all other conditions imposed by this Court in its order dated 06.10.2020 in Crl.OP.No.15710 of 2020 stand unaltered.
