O R D E R

The petitioner has filed this petition seeking to direct the 1st respondent to withdraw the investigation in Cr.No.154 of 2018, on the file of the 2nd respondent herein, and transfer the investigation to any other independent investigation agency for the purpose of conducting fair investigation in Cr.NO.154 of 2018 in accordance with law.

2. The grounds raised by the counsel for the petitioners are all factual in nature and it requires appreciation of evidence and this Court cannot decide the same in exercise of its jurisdiction under Section 482 of Criminal Procedure Code. It is left open to the petitioner to raise all



the grounds before the Investigating Officer and the same shall be considered on its own merits and in accordance with law. This Court is not inclined to interfere with the proceedings pending before the 2nd respondent Police.

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3.It is now represented by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner that without going into the merits of the case, it would suffice, if this Court issues direction to the law enforcing agency to expedite the investigation and complete the same as early as possible.

4.In view of the above, this Court directs the 2nd respondent Police, to expedite the investigation in C.r.No.154 of 2018 and complete the same, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above directions, this criminal original petition is disposed of.
