2. An affidavit has been filed by the Dean of the Government Mohan Kumaramangalam Medical College and Hospital in Salem. Such affidavit indicates that the relevant tea shop owners have been required to shift their shops and the offending canteen has also been removed.

3. In view of the said affidavit and the steps taken, nothing survives of W.P.No.11036 of 2021 which is disposed of. There will be no order as to costs.

4. It is hoped that the disposal of the petition does not result in the offending shops or the canteen being reinstalled.
