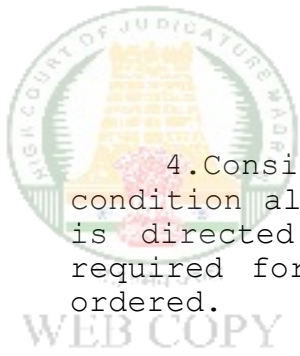

The Petitioner has filed this petition seeking to relax the condition imposed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.5529 of 2021 in Crl.O.P.No.8180 of 2020 for the offences punishable under Sections 7(5) and 20(2) of Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products Act, 2003 and Section 328 of IPC, in Crime No.141 of 2020, while granting anticipatory bail.

2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.



4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition already imposed by this Court is relaxed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the respondent police, as and when required for interrogation on receipt of summons. This petition is ordered.
