This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking suspension of sentence imposed against the petitioner in the judgment dated 15.06.2020 passed in C.A.No.76 of 2019 on the file of the Principal District and Sessions Judge, Namakkal, confirming the judgment dated 01.11.2019 passed in S.C.No.15 of 2013 on the file of the Additional Assistant Sessions Judge, Namakkal.

The petitioner had already filed CrI.M.P.No.4523 of 2020 before this Court and this Court gave its anxious consideration and taking into account the gravity of the offence held that, this is not a fit case to suspend the sentence. This Court had also directed the Registry to post the Criminal Revision Case for final hearing immediately after the resumption of physical hearing.

3. In view of the above, since there is no change of circumstances, the Criminal Miscellaneous Petition stands dismissed. However, a direction is issued to the Registry to prepare the typed set of papers and list the Criminal Revision Case, for final hearing during the third week of December 2021.
