2. It is seen from records that this is the second anticipatory bail petition filed by the petitioner. The previous order, dismissing the Criminal Original petition in CrI.O.P.No.7226 of 2021 was passed by this Court on 22.03.2021.

3. The learned Government Advocate (CrI. side) submitted that there is no change in circumstances after the previous order was passed on merits. Hence, the learned Government Advocate vehemently opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

4. In view of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate, further no change of circumstances arises for considering second anticipatory bail. This Criminal Original petition is dismissed.
