PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.439 of Cr.P.C.

PRAYER :-

To enlarge the Petitioner/Accused on bail in connection with
crime No.411 of 2021 pending investigation on the file of the
respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested on 23.04.2021 for the
offences punishable under Sections 379 IPC read with 21(1) of Mines
and Minerals (Development and Registration) Act, 1957 in Crime No.411
of 2021,on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is said
to have involved in the illegal theft of half unit of river sand at
Thirukalambur, Verraru near by using bullock cart.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner is an innocent person and he is under judicial custody
from 23.04.2021 ad seeks bail.

4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the
respondent strongly opposes the petition and however, he submits that
no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

5. Taking note of the fact that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 23.04.2021 and there is no previous case pending against him, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvavarur and on further condition that:

a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am., until further orders.

c) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

e) On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

f) If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.

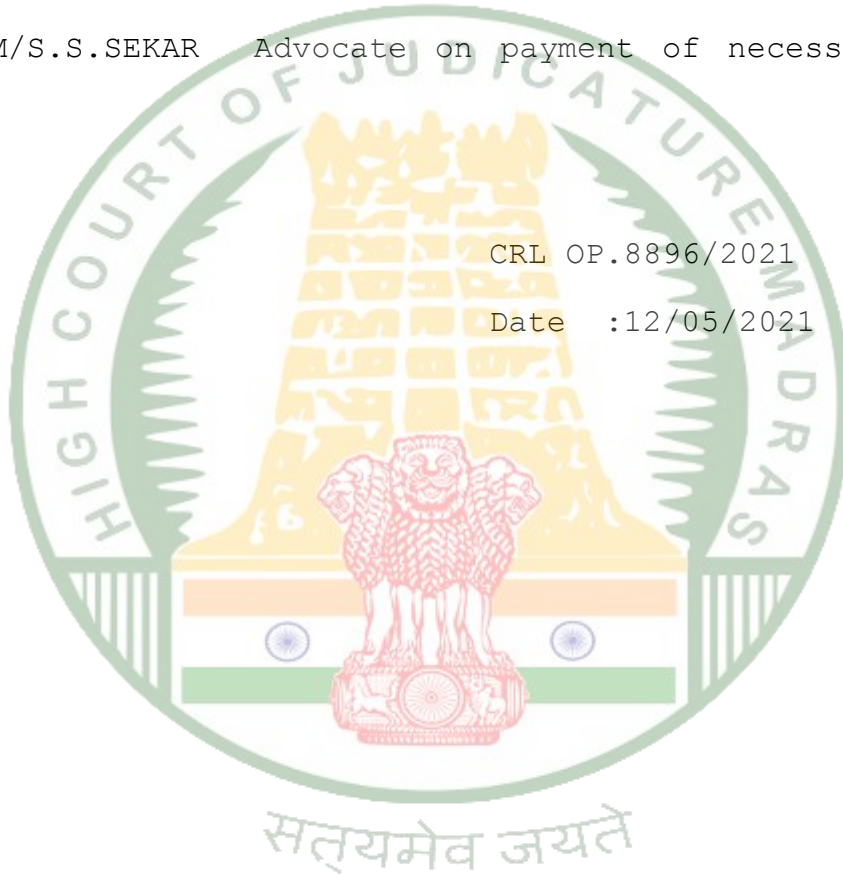
