PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Section 294(b), 341, 506(i) of IPC and Section 4 of TN Prohibition of Women Harassment Act, in Crime No.335 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on the date of occurrence, the petitioner waylaid the de-facto complainant and abused her in filthy language and also threatened her with dire consequences. Hence the complaint.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) would submit that the petitioner waylaid the de-facto complainant and abused her in filthy language and also threatened her with dire consequences. He would further submit that the petitioner is a history-sheeter and there are six previous cases pending against him including murder case. Hence, he opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5.Considering the nature of allegation levelled against the petitioner and also the antecedents of the petitioner are reported to be bad, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
