PRAYER: Criminal Original petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of arrest in Crime No.154 of 2021 on the file of respondent police.

ORDER

The petitioner/A1, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for an offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 324, 307 & 506(ii) IPC r/w. Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Women Harassment Act in Crime No.154 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused person had attacked the defacto complainant's son and caused injury. Based on the complaint given by the defacto complainant, the respondent police registered an FIR.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the false complaint has been given against the petitioner and he has not connected with the crime as alleged by the prosecution.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that the victim has been discharged from the hospital and he has no objection for grant of bail.

5. This Court considered the submissions made by the learned counsel for all the parties concerned and also perused the FIR.

6. The Supreme Court has laid down the law regarding grant of anticipatory bail in the case of **Gurbaksh Singh Vs. State (AIR 1980 SC 1632)** and considering the fact that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary and the fact that there is no apprehension that the petitioner may abscond, the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Kalasapakkam, Thiruvannamalai District., on condition that the petitioner shall execute own bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the said Magistrate, within a period of one month from the date of normal functioning of the Court below, and further condition that:

[a] the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

[b] the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

[c] the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;

[d] the petitioner shall appear before the Court below, whenever required.

[d] the petitioner shall affix his photograph and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of his Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure his/her identity.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229A IPC.

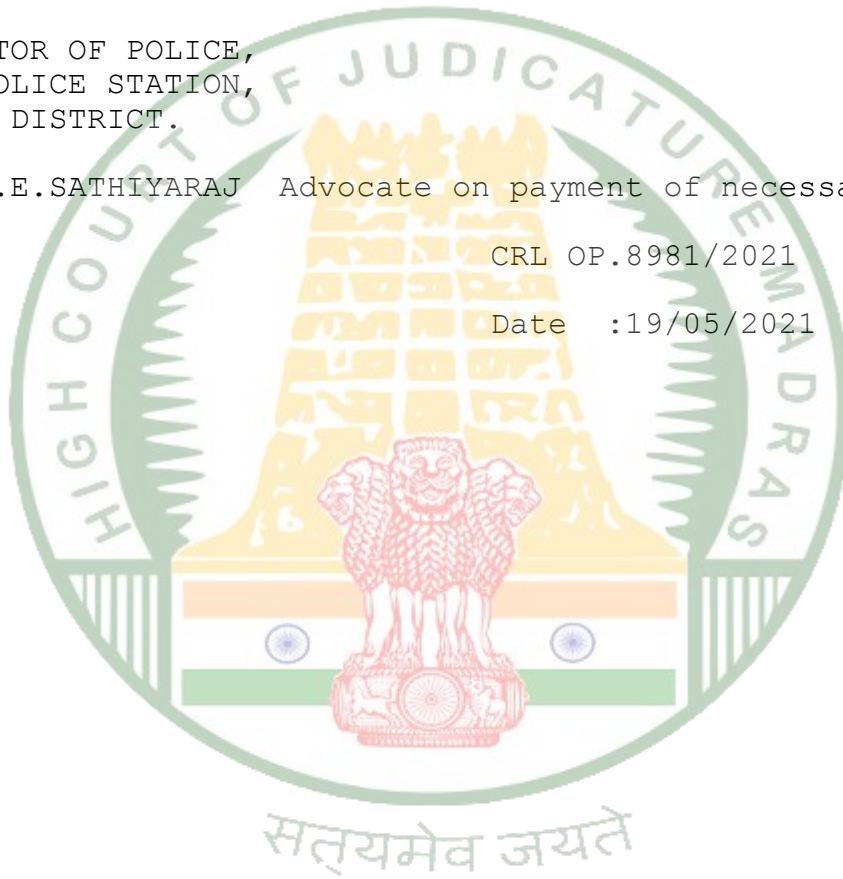
