C O M M O N J U D G M E N T

The Civil Miscellaneous Appeals on hand are preferred against the fair and decreetal order dated 01.04.2019, passed in I.A.Nos.402 & 403 of 2018 respectively in O.S.No.77 of 2018.

2. On perusal of the order under challenge reveals that the interim injunction restraining the respondent from alienating or encumbering the suit property was granted till 16.04.2019. Thus, the validity of the interim order granted by the trial court expired and thus no further adjudication needs to be entertained in respect of the grounds raised in the civil miscellaneous appeals. The parties are at liberty to work out their remedy in the manner known to law.

3. With these observations, the civil miscellaneous appeals stand closed. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

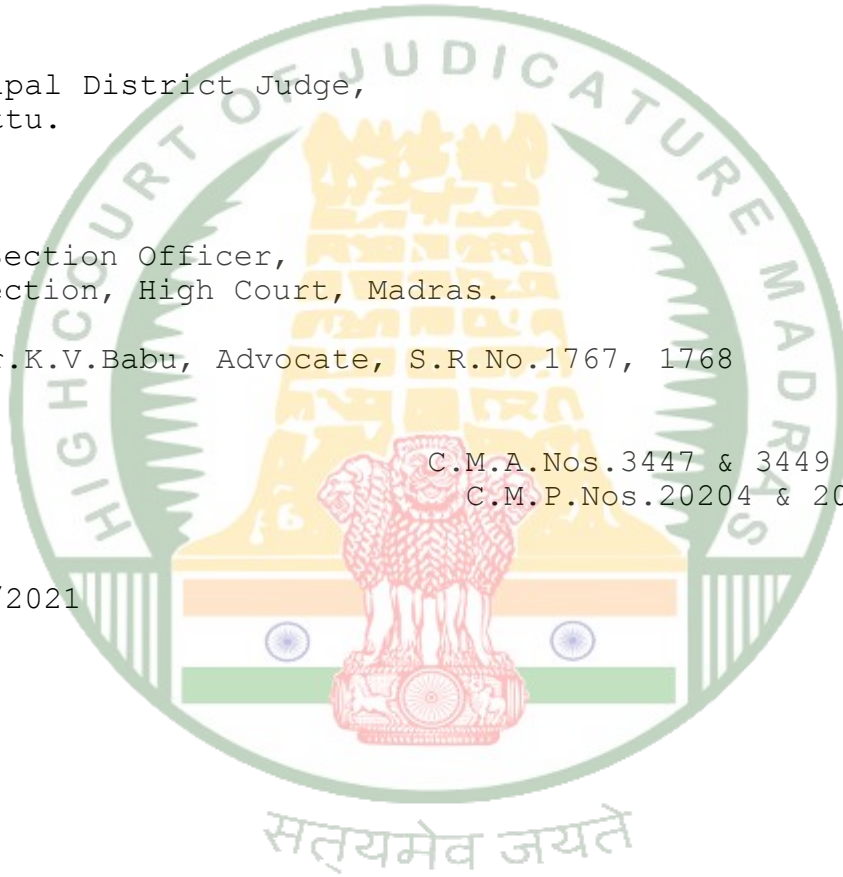
