2. The petitioner prays for a mandamus directing the 2nd respondent, the Tahsildar, Villupuram to issue subdivision patta in regard to the property at 104/1B, situated at Trichy Main Road, Poonthottam Limit, Villupuram District to an extent of 6340 sq.ft. He has also filed representations dated 09.04.2021 and 13.04.2021 respectively, which have been received and acknowledged by the respondents.

3. In the light of the aforesaid and bearing in mind that Mr.Singh has no objection, the following order is passed:

A Mandamus is issued directing the 2nd respondent to consider the representations, hear the petitioner as well as respondents 3 to 6 and pass orders on the representations dated 09.04.2021 and 13.04.2021, within a period of eight (8) weeks from today, in accordance with law.

4. The writ petition is disposed in the aforesaid terms.
