ORDER

The petitioner who was arrested on 18.03.2021 and remanded to judicial custody for the offences under Sections 294(b), 353, 506(ii) and 307 of IPC and Section 3 (1) Prevention of Damage to the Public Property Damage Act and Section 4(b) of Explosives Substance Act, in Cr.No.117 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with other accused persons had abused and attacked the police officials with knife, broke the door of the police check-post and also threatened them with dire consequences. Hence the complaint was registered.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 18.03.2021. Hence, he prays for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submit that there are two previous cases pending against the petitioner. He would further submit that the petitioner is a close associate of one Nedunkundram Surya/A1 who is a notorious accused, involved in 55 other cases. Hence, He vehemently opposed grant of bail to the petitioner.

5.Considering the fact that there two previous cases pending against the petitioner and the gravity of the offence, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
