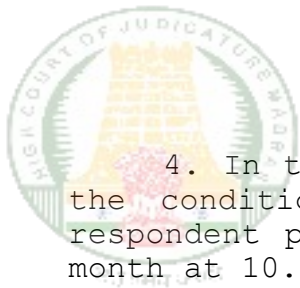

Order : This petition coming on for orders upon perusing the petition and upon hearing the arguments of M/S.M.MARIAPPAN, Advocate for the petitioner and of Mr.C.E.Pratap Government Advocate (Crl. Side) on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

The present petition has been filed to relax the condition imposed on the petitioner in Para 4 of the order dated 17.12.2020 passed by this Court in Crl.M.P.No.8044 of 2020 in Crl.O.P.No.11288 of 2020

2. This Court, vide order dated 17.12.2020, directed the petitioner to appear before the respondent police every first and third Monday of every month at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.

3. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that the petitioner is suffering from COVID-19, and hence, the petitioner has not complying with the conditions imposed by this Court.



4. In the above circumstances, this petition is allowed relaxing the condition by permitting the petitioner to appear before the respondent police once in a month i.e. on first working day of every month at 10.30 a.m, until further orders, after recovery of COVID-19.
