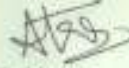

JOINT MEMO FILED BY THE PETITIONER AND THE RESPONDENT

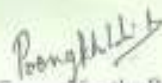
It is submitted as follows:

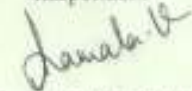

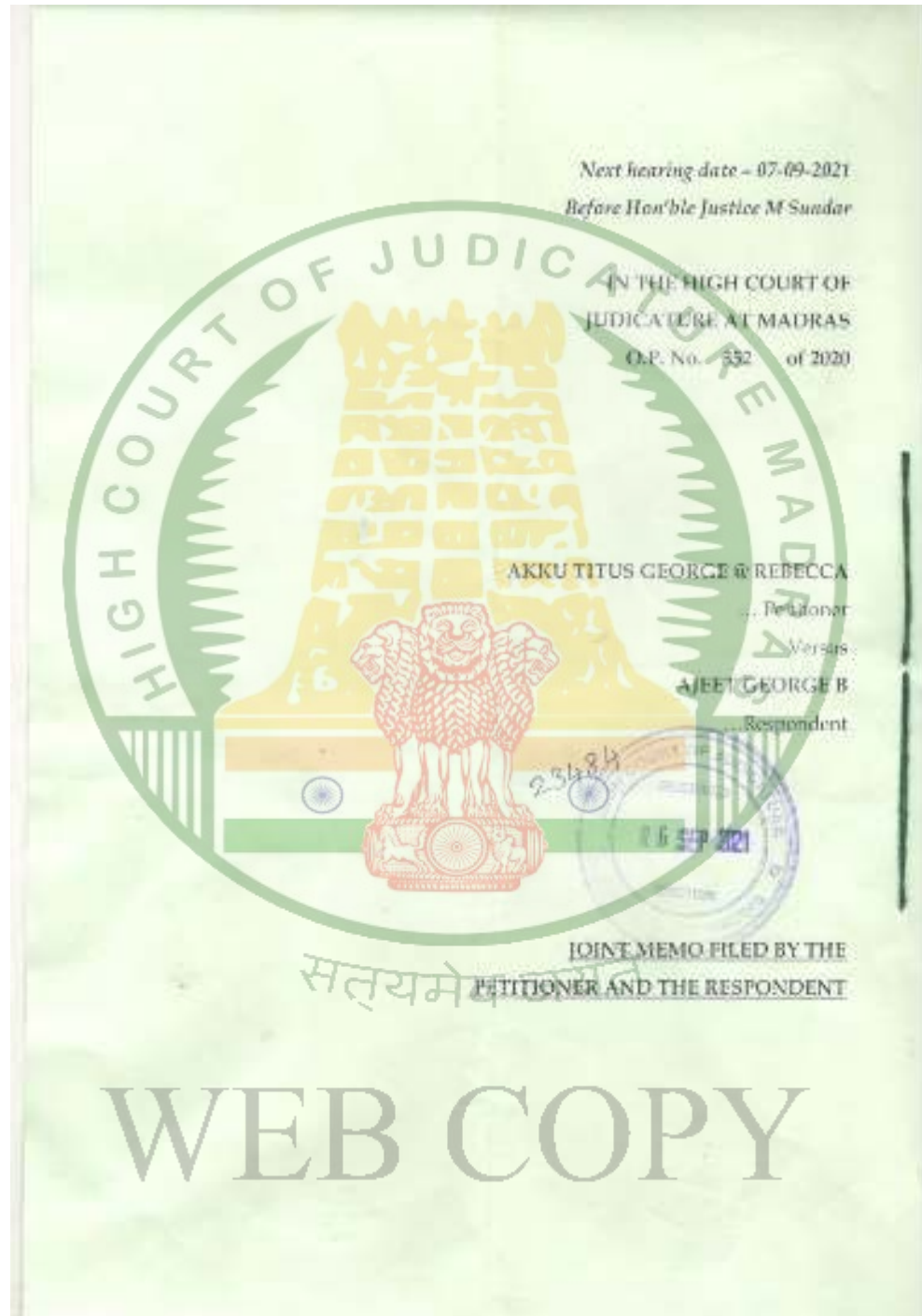

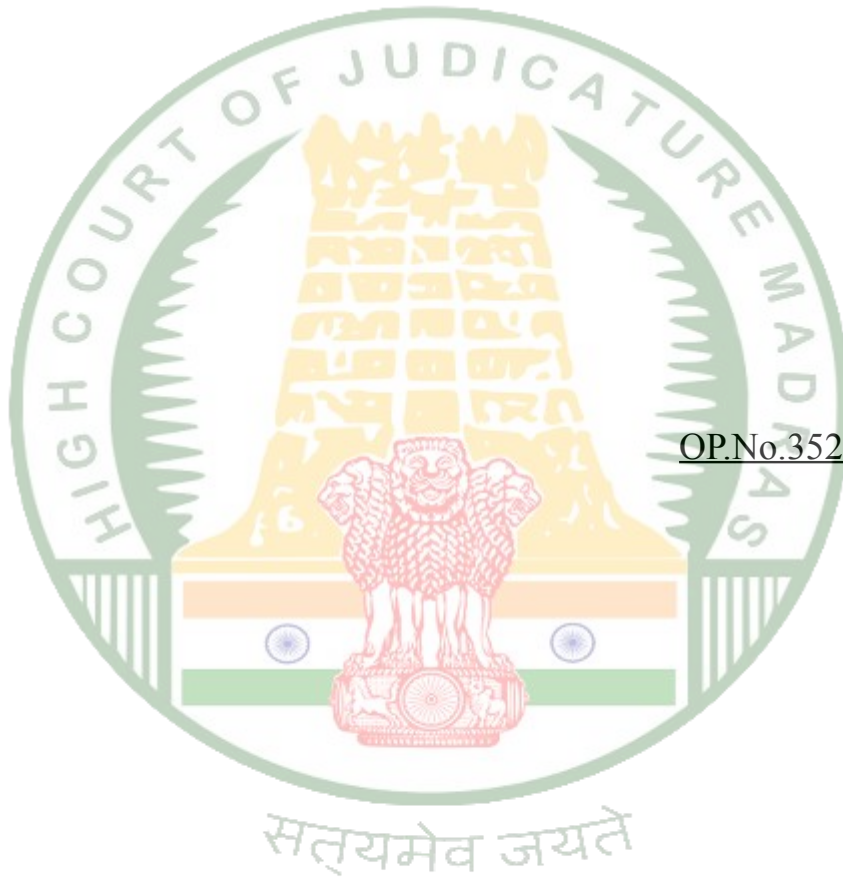


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
