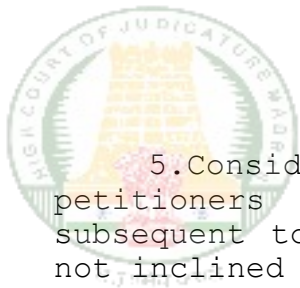
O R D E R

The petitioners who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 07.05.2021 for the offence under Sections 395 and 397 of IPC in Cr.No.1385 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police, seek bail.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that the petitioners along with the other accused are alleged to have committed theft of 220 grams of gold and 2-1/2 Kgs. of silver ornaments.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners would submit that the petitioners have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (CrI. Side) submitted that the petitioners are arrayed as A6 and A7 and further submitted that as against A6 there are four previous cases and as against A7 there are five previous cases and further submitted that earlier, the petitioners approached this Court by filing CrI.O.P.No.9665 of 2021 and this Court vide order dated 26.05.2021 dismissed the said petition.



5.Considering the number of previous cases as against the petitioners and since there is no change in circumstances subsequent to the order passed in Crl.O.P.No.9665 of 2021, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, the criminal original petition is dismissed.
