PRAYER: Criminal Original petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, prayed to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of arrest in Crime No.150 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

**ORDER**

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 341,294(b)395,397 and 506(ii) of I.P.C in Crime No.150 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner robbed a sum of Rs.640/- from the defacto complainant. Hence, the law enforcing agency registered a case against the petitioner.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. On instructions, learned counsel further submits that without prejudice to his defence and contentions, the petitioner, on his own volition, is ready to deposit Rs.10,000/- in favour of The Dean, Standley Medical College, Chennai for treating Covid-19 patients and ready to deposit Rs.1,000/- to the credit of crime No.150 of 2021. Therefore, he prays to grant bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate( Crl side) opposed the grant of bail by stating that the petitioner robbed a sum of Rs.640/- from the defacto complainant.

5.Considering the facts of the case and the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for either side, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned learned XV M.M.G.T. Chennai on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a) the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) in favour of The Dean, Standley Medical College, Chennai for treating Covid-19 patients. The said payments shall be made through NEFT/RTGS/Cash/Demand Draft and acknowledgement of payment shall be produced before the learned XV M.M.G.T. Chennai; the petitioner is further directed to deposit a sum of Rs.1,000/- to the credit of crime no.150 of 2021 which shall be disbursed to the defacto complainant by the trial Court upon filing a proper affidavit.

(b) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Court concerned may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(c) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(g) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
