PRAYER: Criminal Original Petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, to enlarge the petitioner on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest by the respondent Police in Crime No.710 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

O R D E R

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Section 147, 148, 294(b), 324 and 506(ii) IPC in Cr.No.710 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the defacto complainant is one of the Trustee of Shri Angala Parameshwari Temple at Guduvanchery. The dispute between the defacto complainant and the petitioner is with regard to the dumping of wastes in front of the petitioner's house and when it was questioned by the petitioner, there was a wordy quarrel between them and after some time, the petitioner along with other accused persons have caused cut injuries to the defacto complainant, due to which he was hospitalised. Based on the complaint of the defacto complainant, the Law Enforcing Agency has registered a case against the petitioner.



3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and she has been falsely implicated in this case. Hence, the learned counsel prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that the injured person has been discharged from the hospital and there is no previous case pending against the petitioner.

5. Considering the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and there is also no previous case against the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Chengalpattu, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that:

(a)the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Court concerned may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders;

(c)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
