The petitioner is complainant. The respondents are accused. The petitioner had filed a private complaint against the respondents for the offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Fast Track Court No.I at Magisterial Level, Coimbatore and the learned Magistrate taken the complaint on file in C.C.No.383 of 2016 and after completion of trial, dismissed the complaint and acquitted the respondents. 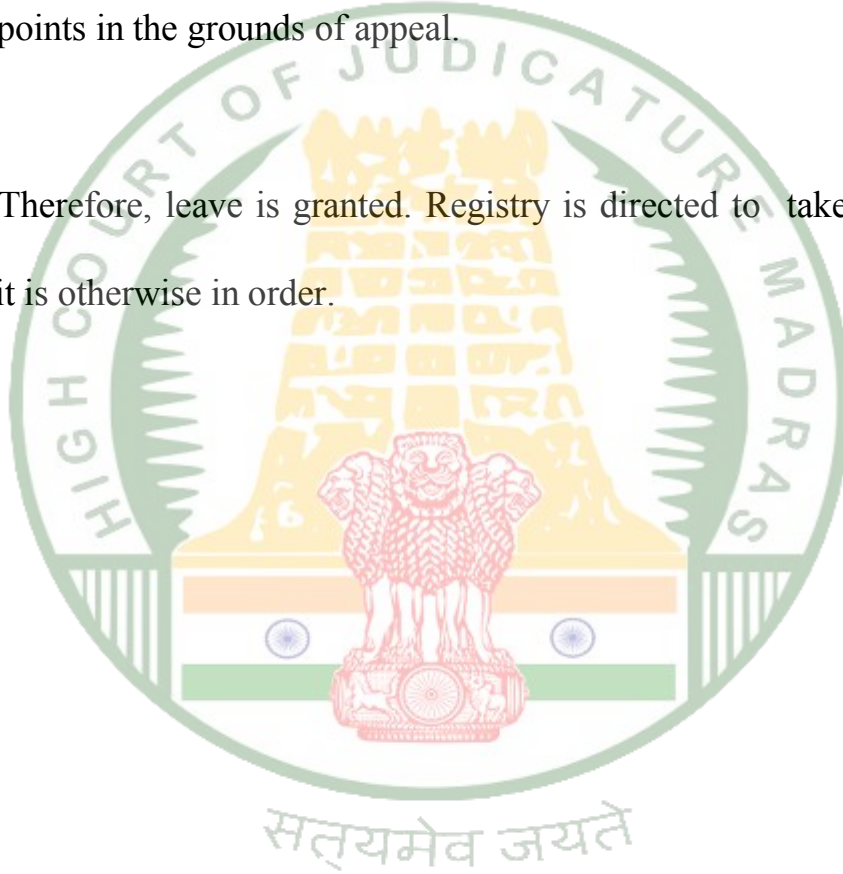
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3. Heard the learned Counsel for the petitioner and he has raised arguable points in the grounds of appeal.
