Section 3 of Epidemic Diseases Act, 1897 and Section 7 of Tamil Nadu Essential Commodities Act in Crime No.186 of 2021, while granting bail.

2.Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the petitioner is complying with the condition regularly.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the condition already imposed on the petitioner is relaxed and the
