3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the respondent would submit that based on the complaint given by the de facto complainant, petition enquiry is pending and the petitioner has to necessarily appear before the respondent/police for enquiry.

4.In view of the above, this petition is not maintainable by invoking Section 482 Cr.P.C., and hence, this Court is not inclined to interfere with power of investigating officer.
