A.Nos.3110 and 3111 of 2021 have been filed by the applicants/ plaintiffs seeking to condone the delay of 110 days in filing the application to set aside the ex-parte order passed in O.A.Nos.1080 and 1081 of 2020 in C.S.No.678 of 2019.

2. The learned counsel for the respondents/defendants has not raised any serious objection for allowing the aforementioned applications.
