The writ petition has been filed seeking a direction directing the respondents 1 and 2 to dispose the petitioner's representation dated 09.07.2021 requesting to cancel the patta issued in favour of 4th respondent.



2. In view of the order is going to be passed in the present Writ Petition, which will not prejudice the interest of the respondents 3 and 4, notice to the respondents 3 and 4 are dispensed with.

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3. The grievance of the petitioner is that against the order of granting patta in favour of 4th respondent, the petitioner said to have submitted a representation before the respondents 1 and 2 on 09.07.2021 to cancel the patta for the property comprised in Old Punjai Survey No.633/6A2, New Survey No.633/6A2B situate at No.84, Orathy Village.
