On 14.10.2020, the learned Master passed an order directing the Judgement Debtor to pay 50% of the decretal amount in the Execution Petitions within four weeks, failing which the Decree Holder may take steps for attachment by filing batta memo, against which, the applications were filed before this Court in Application Nos.2663, 2664 & 2665 of 2020 and this Court vide order dated 10.11.2020, directed the applicant to deposit 25% of the decretal amount. According to the applicant, the order of this Court dated 10.11.2020 was complied with. Subsequently, this Court vide order dated 13.04.2020, directed the applicant/Judgement Debtor to make payment of a sum of Rs.7,03,94,092/- towards execution of Arbitral Awards on or before 20.04.2022. The said order was not complied with and therefore, this Court vide order dated 21.04.2022, has passed an order of attachment and granted liberty to pay the batta for attachment.

2. The learned counsel appearing for the applicant/judgement debtor would submit that an attachment has been effected.



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3. In view of the above, since the attachment is already ordered, this Court is of the considered view that no further order is required. Hence all these applications are closed.

4. Post the matter before the Master for further proceedings in the E.Ps, on 04.08.2022. Since the matter is pending from 2020, the learned Master is directed to expedite the proceedings.
