Vide Order dated 08.12.2020 in Crl.O.P.No.19132 of 2020, this Court had enlarged the petitioners on anticipatory bail on certain conditions. This petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking relaxation of the conditions.

2. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent, on instruction, submits that the petitioners have been complying with the conditions without fail.

3. In view of the above submission, this Court is of the considered view that the prayer as sought for by the petitioner could be acceded to.



4. Accordingly, the condition insofar as appearance as imposed by order dated 08.12.2020 alone stands relaxed and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation. All other conditions remain unaltered.
