The petitioner is the wife of the detenu viz., Suresh Kumar @ Mental Suresh s/o.Vijayakumar, aged about 25 years. The detenu has been detained by the second respondent by his order in BCDFGISSSV No.26/2021 dated 19.06.2021, holding him to be a "Goonda", as contemplated under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982. The said order is under challenge in this Habeas Corpus Petition.

Learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the detention order passed against the detenu in BCDFGISSSV No.26/2021 dated 19.06.2021, on the file of the second respondent is revoked vide G.O.Rt.No.3335, Home, Prohibition and Excise (XI) Department, dated 28.07.2021 and produced a copy of the said order.

In view of the above, this petition is closed as it has become infructuous.
