ORDER

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, without going into the merits of the case, the petitioner is permitted to submit a fresh representation to the 1st and 2nd respondents within two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on receipt of the same, the 1st and 2nd respondents are directed to consider the same as pass orders, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and communicate the decision taken, to the petitioner herein.

5. With the above directions, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
