



5. In view of the above position, this Court is of the opinion that the relief available to the petitioners is to surrender before the learned Magistrate concerned and to file a petition under Section 70(2) of Cr.P.C. to recall the Non Bailable Warrant of Arrest issued against them. Therefore, the question of granting anticipatory bail does not at all arise.

6. Considering the fact that non-bailable warrant is pending against the petitioners, the petitioners are directed to surrender before the trial Court i.e., learned Judicial Magistrate, Tiruttani, Tiruvallur District and file a petition under Section 70(2) of Cr.P.C., to recall the non bailable warrant. On filing of such petition, the learned Judicial Magistrate, Tiruttani, Tiruvallur District is directed to consider the said petition on merits and pass orders on the same day.

7. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is disposed of.
