Thereafter, the petitioner had approached this Court by filing Crl.O.P.No.2451 of 2021 seeking for a direction to the learned Judicial Magistrate, Arni to entertain the complaint.

2. This Court, by an order dated 06.02.2020, disposed the said petition stating that as per Section 142(2) of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the jurisdiction has been assigned and in this case, the petitioner has presented the cheque before the State Bank of India, Ambattur Industrial Estate Branch, Chennai.
