C.E.PRATAP, Govt. Advocate (Crl. Side) on behalf of the Respondent the court made the following order:-

The Petitioners have filed this petition seeking to modify the condition directing the petitioners to appear before the respondent police imposed in the order dated 07.07.2021 made in Crl.O.P.No.11594 of 2021.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that the second petitioner has undergone hip-replacement treatment and prayed to modify the condition directing the petitioners to appear before the respondent police.

3.The learned Government Advocate submitted that the second petitioner has been discharged from the hospital as early as on 18.03.2021.



4. On 07.07.2021, when the order was passed, this Court has directed the petitioners to appear before the respondent police daily for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

5. Since the second petitioner has been discharged from the hospital as early as on 18.03.2021, this Court is not inclined to modify the said condition. Hence, this petition is dismissed.
