Today, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that as per the direction of this Court on 03.09.2021, the petitioner has paid the fine amount of Rs.7,50,000/- (Rupees seven lakhs fifty thousand only) to the credit of Special Case No.4 of 2019, on the file of the Special Judge (Principal Sessions Judge), Special Court to try criminal cases involving Members of Parliament and Members of Legislative Assembly of Tamil Nadu, Villupuram and also appeared before the trial Court and executed sureties.
