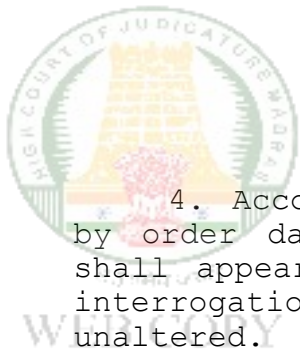

Vide order dated 12.01.2018, this Court had enlarged the petitioner on bail on certain conditions. This petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking further relaxation of the conditions imposed on Crl.M.P.No.2737 of 2018 dated 26.02.2018.

2. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent, on instruction, submits that the petitioner has been complying with the conditions without fail.

3. In view of the above submission, this Court is of the considered view that the prayer as sought for by the petitioner could be acceded to.



4. Accordingly, the condition insofar as appearance as imposed by order dated 26.02.2018 alone stands relaxed and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation until further orders. All other conditions remain unaltered.
