PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 147, 148, 323, 324, 506(ii) of IPC in Cr.No.187 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with the other accused is alleged to have attacked the defacto complainant and obtained false statement from the defacto complainant as if he gave money to some persons for sale of Ganja.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and that he has been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Cr1. Side) submitted that there is one previous case as against the petitioner.

5.Considering the gravity of the offence committed by the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



6. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is dismissed.
