PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent to issue a No Objection Certificate to the Petitioner to run a "SPA" i.e., cross massage in the name and style of "LOTUS VEDIC LINCE WELLNESS CENTRE & SPA" at Door No.17/4A, Cheran Street, Chinna Tirupathi, Salem, Salem District - 636008, by passing orders on petitioners representation dated 22.07.2021.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed to direct the second respondent to issue No Objection Certificate to the Petitioner to run a SPA i.e., cross massage in the name and style of "LOTUS VEDIC LINCE WELLNESS CENTRE & SPA" at Door No.17/4A, Cheran Street, Chinna Tirupathi, Salem, Salem District - 636008, by passing orders on petitioners representation dated 22.07.2021.

2.The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondents on instructions submitted that the petitioner is already running a SPA and the Police are under the impression that already No Objection Certificate was given by the Police. If the petitioner has not obtained any 'No Objection



Certificate', the petitioner can be directed to approach the second respondent and the second respondent will consider the grant of 'No Objection Certificate' to the petitioner.

3. Recording the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side), this Writ Petition is disposed of, with a direction to the petitioner to make a representation to the second respondent seeking 'No Objection Certificate' for running the business and the second respondent, on receipt of the representation, shall consider the same, and issue 'No Objection Certificate', if the petitioner satisfies all the requirements. In the event of 'No Objection Certificate' is granted, the respondents shall not, thereafter interfere with the business of the petitioner, until it is run in accordance with law. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is closed. No costs.
