With regard to the representation of the third and fourth respondents that they would permit free access to the petitioner to visit the child viz., Ritesh Vickram peacefully without causing trouble, we permit the petitioner to visit Ritesh Vickram during weekends in the house of the third and fourth respondents without causing any trouble, if he so desires. It is made clear that this is purely a temporary arrangement until appropriate orders are passed by the competent Court. However, the petitioner cannot forcibly take away the child from the custody of the third and fourth respondents.

With the above directions, this habeas corpus petition stands closed.
