4. The respondents, who are the other legal heirs of the deceased, have also given consent affidavits stating 'no objection' for grant of Succession Certificate in favour of the petitioner, who is their brother, as seen from Exhibits P10 and P11.

5. As seen from the aforementioned documents, which have been

marked as Exhibits, it is clear that the petitioner and the respondents are the

only legal heirs of the deceased C.D.V.Raghavulu, who died on 23.09.2015



and the respondents have also given consent in favour of the petitioner for the grant of Succession Certificate in favour of the petitioner.

6. An averment has also been made in the petition that no application has been made to the District Court or delegate or to any High Court for Probate of any Will of the deceased or Letters of Administration with or without the Will annexed to his properties and credits. No application for Succession Certificate in respect of any debts or security belonging to the estate of the deceased has been made to any District Court or delegate or to any High Court.

7. After perusing and examining the pleadings, evidence and materials available on record, this Court is inclined to grant the succession certificate in favour of the petitioner as prayed for in O.P No.618 of 2020. Accordingly, this Original Petition is allowed.
