The petitioner challenges the impugned order of detention in Memo No.326/BCDFGISSSV/2020 on 25.08.2020, detaining her brother as "Goonda" under Section 2(f) of the Tamil Nadu Act 14 of 1982.

2. Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on instructions, submitted that, the detenu died on 22.01.2021, due to cardiac arrest, while he was in judicial custody in the Central Prison, Puzhal, Chennai and he also produced a copy of his Death Certificate.

3. Recording the same, this Habeas Corpus Petition stands closed.
