J U D G M E N T

This Criminal Revision case is preferred against the summons issued by the 1st respondent for appearance of the petitioners to conduct enquiry on 22.11.2014, for offences under Section 145 of the Criminal Procedure Code, before the Court of Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Tirupur.

2. Heard, Mr.L.Baskaran, learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondents.

3. As per the facts, the 1st respondent passed an order dated 22.11.2014, by invoking Sections 145 of the Criminal Procedure Code, which would be valid for a year. Based upon that, summon was sent on 22.11.2014 to the petitioners for appearing enquiry on 24.11.2014.
