Petition filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C., seeking to enlarge the petitioner on bail pending investigation in Crime No.905 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

O R D E R

The petitioner who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.07.2021 for the offence under Section 174 @ 306 of I.P.C. in Crime No.905 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2.It is the case of the prosecution that the deceased got separated from her husband and was living with the petitioner and due to wordy quarrel between them, she committed suicide.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and would further submit that the petitioner did not induce the deceased to commit suicide and that the petitioner has to take care of his female child.

4.Heard the submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side).



5. Considering the fact that the petitioner has to take care of his female child and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties, of whom, one should be a blood related surety, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned District Munsif Cum Judicial Magistrate, Madhavaram and on further condition that:

(a) the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police, daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders;

(c) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(f) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
