This was opposed by the parents of the girl and threat was exerted against the petitioner and his family members. The petitioner, therefore, gave a complaint before the first respondent police on 01.10.2020. 3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for petitioner and the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing on behalf of respondents 1 and 2.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and the nature of grievance expressed by the

petitioner, there shall be a direction to the first respondent to call the concerned parties and also the petitioner for an enquiry and ensure that no threat is exerted by any of the parties and shall direct the parties to work out their remedy in the manner known to law.

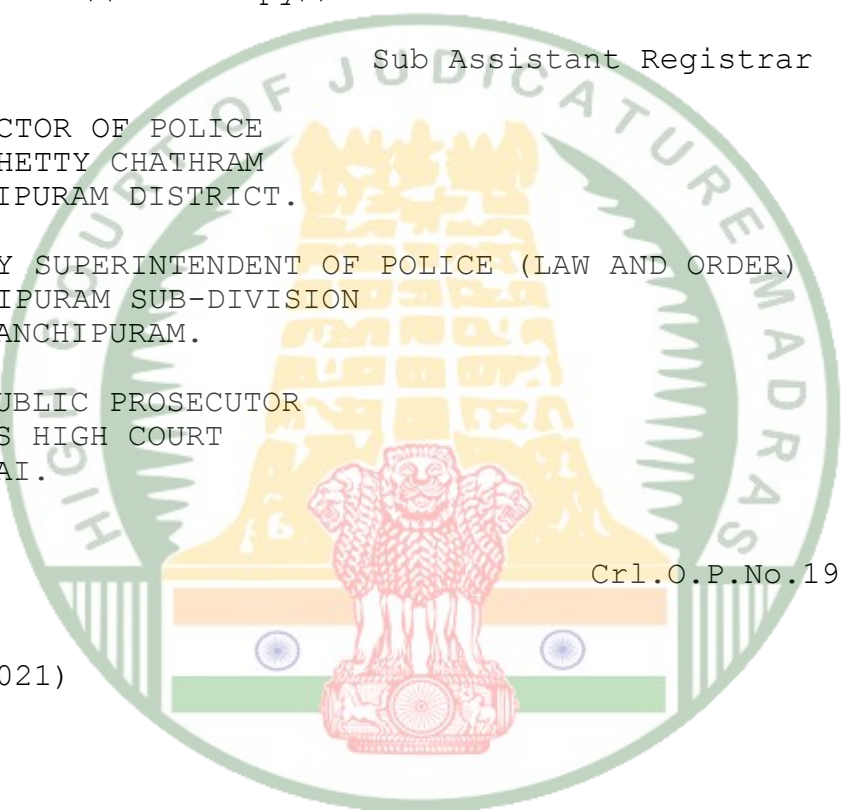
